In late April, a pilot project dubbed “Just Do It (JDI)” began with the goal of collecting as much parcel data as possible and assembling the data into a seamless parcel dataset. The purpose of this project is to demonstrate to other organizations, policy-makers and legislators the value of statewide data layers.

As of today, we have collected data from 59 counties and 2 cities. There have been 5 counties, shown as black in the map, that stated they would not contribute data to our project. That leaves us with 8 counties that haven’t responded to our request.

The JDI team will be presenting preliminary findings at the WLIA Fall Regional in Appleton October 23rd with the final report being presented at the WLIA Annual Conference in Lake Geneva February 13-15th, 2013.
